Projects which confer a private benefit upon members of the applying club; deficit financing; projects for commercial ventures; projects which require NRA membership; multi-year financing, operating expenses, groups that have not submitted a final report from a previously awarded grant, political candidates or organizations; labor organizations.

All grant applications receive a complete legal review for eligibility. Upon legal review, if successful, the grants are forwarded to the NRA Foundation Board of Trustees for final review and approval/disapproval.

All recipients are required to file a final report following completion of their project/activity. Any unexpended grant funds are required to be returned to the Foundation.
